# **Medical Fitness to Drive Certificates**

South Australia has removed the compulsory annual assessment for car licence holders aged 70 and older and who **DO NOT** have a medical condition that could affect their ability to drive.

This means that you **WILL** be asked to visit a doctor and submit a Certificate of Fitness form it you **do HAVE** a medical condition recorded against your driver's licence or you are 70 years and older and hold a class of licence other than for a car.

You will **no longer** need to visit a doctor each year to assess your fitness to drive if you are aged 70 years and older, you only hold a car (C class) driver's licence and you **DO NOT** have a medical condition recorded against your licence.

A self assessment will be introduced MID 2015 to allow older drivers to assess their own fitness to drive. From the age of 75, if you only have a car licence and you DO NOT have a medical condition, you will receive a self assessment form in the mail to complete.


