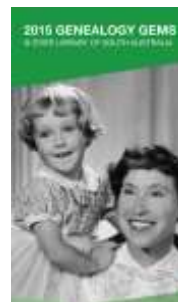

The 1915 Dardanelles (or Gallipoli) Campaign in Turkey is regarded as one of the biggest Allied defeats of the First World War. Join presenter Kelvin Crombie for the premiere of his documentary where he leads us on a journey to Britain, Europe, Turkey, Israel, Jordan, New Zealand and Australia. He discovers, in the process, that a road began at Gallipoli which was destined to lead to Jerusalem.

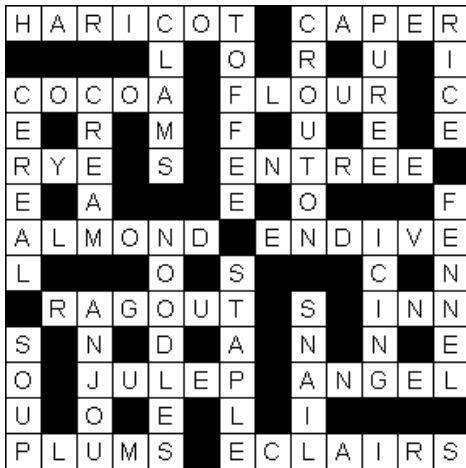

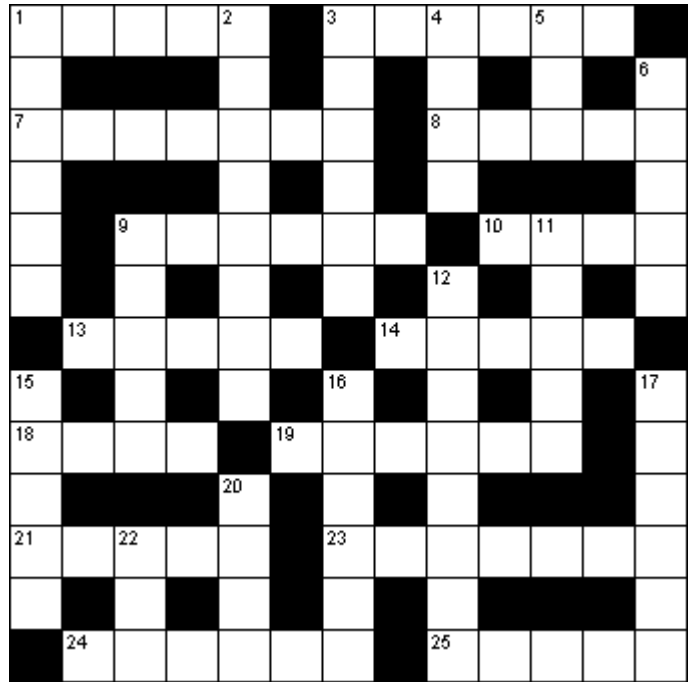
