A touching addition this year was the kindergarten children, assisted by Mrs. Manners and Lisa, who laid handmade poppies during the wreath laying ceremony.

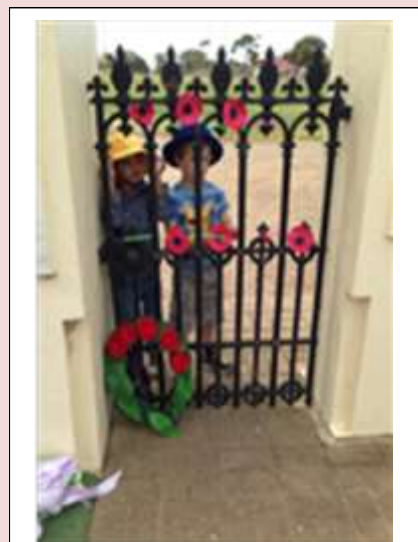

Welcome Swallow *Hirundo neoxena*

Common in all habitats. Swallows take advantage of buildings and houses for building their mud nests. In some of these situations they are not so welcome.

White-Backed Swallow *Cheramoeca leucosternus*



Occurs in small numbers and most likely to be seen in pairs near sandy rises where they dig a tunnel to nest. Wild Dog Hill, a few kilometres north of Port Wakefield is a favoured breeding site.

Barn Swallow *Hirundo rustica*

Rare. A recently discovered visitor to Australia, mainly in the north.



The Barn Swallow is similar to a Welcome Swallow but has a black chest band.

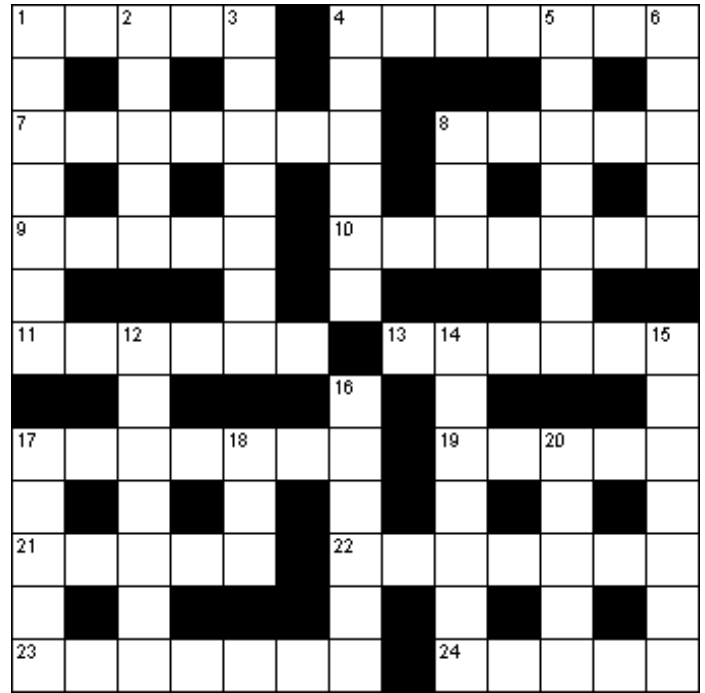

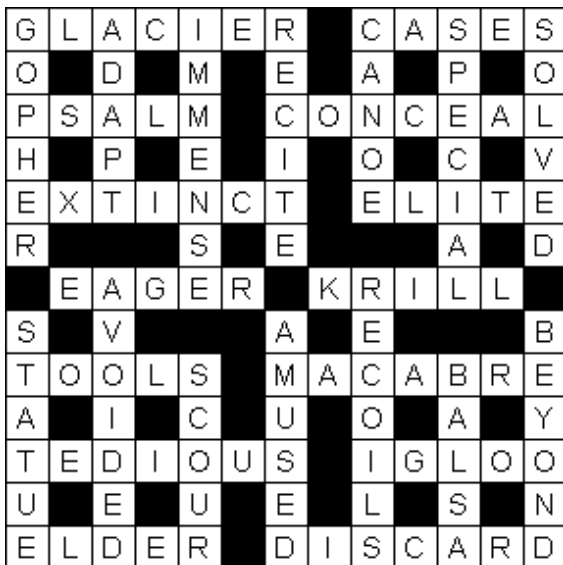
