

1. programs and equipment request only,

2. facility requests and programs and equipment.

The next round of the Active Club Program will be for facility requests plus program and equipment

Eligible organisations

Incorporated sport or active recreation clubs that do not have a gaming machine licence.

Community Recreation and Sport Facilities Program

The Community Recreation and Sport Facilities Program helps eligible organisations to plan, establish or improve sport and active recreation facilities that meet the needs of the community in South Australia.

Organisations can apply under the each of the following categories:

*Category 1 - facility planning

*Category 2 – facitlity development (\$1 - \$200,000)

*Category 3 – facility development (\$200,001 - \$1m)
