



Remember to continue with Social Distancing and hand sanitizing so we all continue to stay safe.






The Port Wakefield Community

Pasta carbonara

Ingredients

380g fettuccine or pasta of choice 120g bacon roughly chopped 1 small brown onion, finely chopped 500ml Campbell's Real Stock Salt-Reduced chicken

2 eggs

1 egg yolk

1 cup finely grated cheese

Fresh parsley, roughly chopped

Method

- 1. Cook pasta in a large pan of boiling water according to packet directions or until al dente. Drain well and return to the pan.
- 2. Meanwhile, heat a medium non-stick pan. Cook the bacon and onion, stirring often for 3-4 minutes or until lightly golden and a little crisp. Remove from pan.
- 3. Add the stock to the pan and heat until almost boiling. Remove from the heat.
- 4. Whisk the eggs, yolk and some freshly cracked black pepper in a large heatproof bowl. Gradually whisk in the warm stock until combined. Do this slowly so the eggs don't scramble.
- 5. Add the bacon and half the cheese to the hot pasta. Pour over the egg mixture and toss to combine. Leave for 2-3 minutes to soak up the egg mixture and thicken slightly.
- 6. Serve pasta topped remaining cheese and extra pepper. Scatter with fresh chopped parsley if you like.

Jacky Winter Microeca fascinans





Fairly common in mallee scrubs and agricultural land. A confident bird that can be approached closely, even when nesting. The Jacky Winter was formerly and formally called the Brown Flycatcher. It is easily recognised by its prominent white outer tail feathers. The Jacky Winter is a small grey-brown robin found commonly throughout Australia and also in Papua New Guinea. The Jacky Winter acquired its name due to rapid and strong vocalisations which sound like jacky-jacky winter-winter. Their call is also often referred to as sounding like peter-peter-peter-peter.

Did you know?

The phrases "start from scratch" and "not up to scratch" come from 19th-century bareknuckle boxing rules. If a fighter was knocked down, they had to return to a mark in the middle of the ring called the "scratch" to prove they could continue the fight.






