The weeds have appeared overnight, it seems, and we need to remove them before they become a bigger problem.


Keep an eye out for the snails, slugs and other pests that can demolish a garden overnight. Collect them by hand or leave something out they can hide in, like boxes, tubes, plastic, or cardboard. Discard as you please.

Now it's June, it's time to prune! To prune choose the bud facing outwards and snip closely above it at a 45 degree angle. This prevents fungus or pests being able to stay on the stem and infect the plant.






