

In the Garden 2021 no.10

This cold snap has made winter feel like it is here now. Winter has a variety of plants to grow, and these may interest you to plant: Virginian Stock, Wall Flower, Pansy, Stock, Livingstone Daisy, Linaria, Calendula (English Marigold), Antirrhinum (Snapdragon), Nasturtium, Scabiosa (Pin-Cushion), Gypsophila all make a nice showing when the winter sets in.

For vegetables, the beds need to receive as much sun as possible. Choose any of these to suit your needs: Beetroot, Carrots, Onions Spinach, Lettuce, Parsnips, Potatoes, Beans.
