## In the Garden 2021 No. 15

Now is the time to prune Hydrangea. If you want to encourage flowers, a hint is to prune the stems back to TWO buds that are together on either side of the stem. It is up to you how short the stem will be. They do not require hard pruning. The single bud will produce foliage. Some stems have only the single bud, you will see, so just cut them to a length you like. When you prune cut at an angle of 45 degrees. The reason for this is to stop bugs and water staying on the stem and causing disease.

When the Roses are pruned you do the same cut with a single bud facing outwards. That allows the rose to breathe and not be filled with foliage in the centre of the plant, so it's less likely to contract a disease.

In the veggie patch you can plant now... Rocket, Dwarf Beans, Coriander, Garlic, Mint, Turnip... In the Flower Garden... Gypsophila, Irish Green Bell, Larkspur, Lavender Shower, Marigold, Mignonette. Enjoy the week, gardening gives us all such pleasure and lowers our blood pressure.

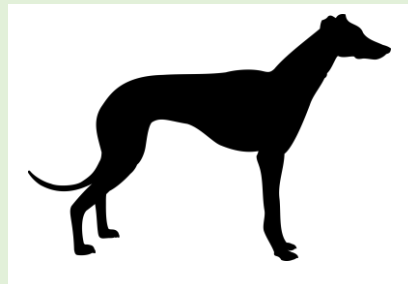

## \$110,000 for Wakefield communities in new-look grants program

A host of community groups will benefit from Wakefield Regional Council's new-look grants program, with \$110,000 awarded for a variety of community initiatives.

Among the headline projects are a toilet and shower block upgrade at Snowtown Centenary Park (\$25,000), solar power in Lochiel (\$7,500), a new community garden at Brinkworth Primary School (\$4,900), and facility upgrades to Balaklava Museum's Urlwin Park (\$10,000).

These projects fall under the major grants category, just one of three separate funding streams available:

- Minor Grants cover up to \$2,000
- Major Grants cover \$2,001 to \$25,000
- Minor to Major Event Sponsorships from \$500 to \$2,000

The event sponsorship applications will be accepted throughout the year until available funding has been expended – details are on Council's website.

Wakefield Mayor Rodney Reid said the program focused on empowering the many hardworking groups in the region and supported community-led projects that help us achieve our Wakefield 2030 vision.

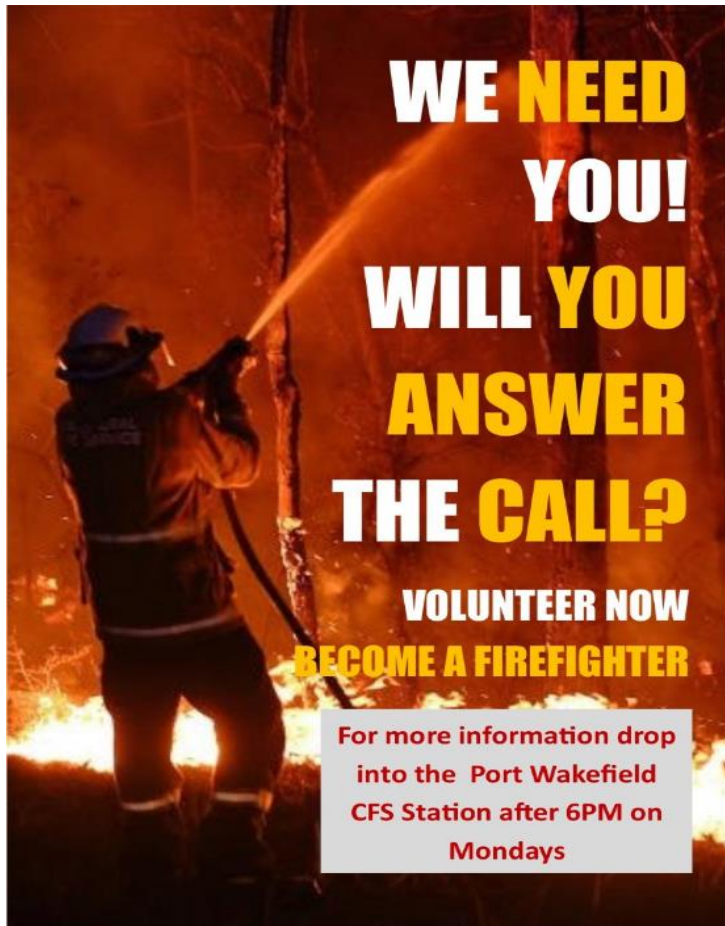

### Yesterday's News

PORT WAKEFIELD

(*Kapunda Herald*, May 26<sup>th</sup>, 1911)

Another large ship is at the anchorage taking in wheat for Verco Bros. There is still a considerable amount on this wharf awaiting shipment. The channel still remains in the same silted up condition, and the powers that be do not seem to be worrying over the shipping facilities of this port. The extension of the wharf is expected to share the same fate. The quantity of merchandise passing over the wharf should prove that something should be done to further the interests of the place, which has been visited by Ministers for years past. They have been feted and treated like kings, but still the same old muddy port remains

Considerable alarm is felt at the increased drunkenness and rowdyism in the town. Last Saturday night fighting was freely indulged in, and so far no steps appear to have been taken to suppress it. On Monday three drunks made an exhibition of themselves near the school and in sight of the children out at recess time. The police were informed, but the offenders were allowed to clear out in a dray to a vacant house on the outskirts of the town, where they held high orgies during the afternoon.

Through having a valuable dog smashed up by a fast travelling motor car, one of the residents of the town has written the Corporation calling attention to the high speed at which these visiting cars travel through the streets.

A sun fish, weighing about 300lb, was captured by the fishermen on Sunday night, and was on view during the greater part of Monday. Some fine hauls of fish have been recorded lately, and the same applies to mushrooms, which have been gathered in large quantities.

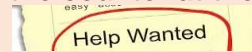

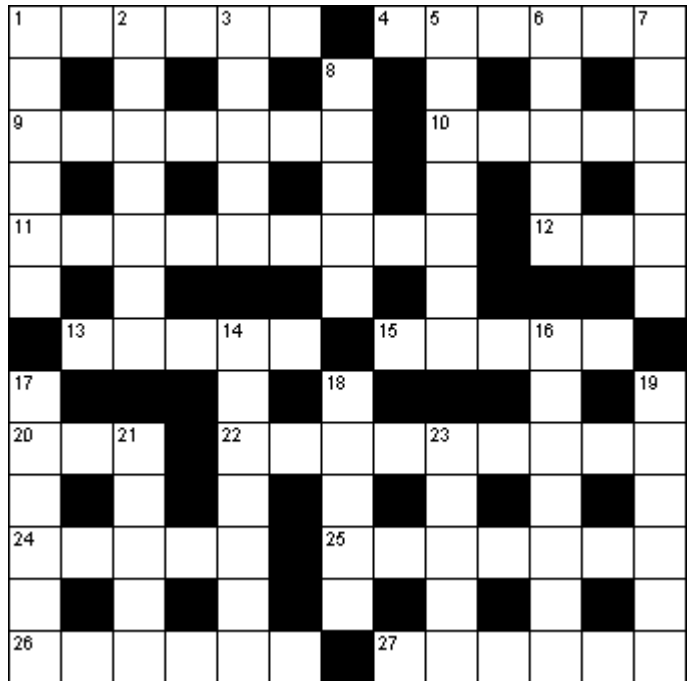
