PORT WAKEFIELD

November 1. — A wandering sailor recently met with a painful experience whilst in search of a place to camp in on the wharf about 8 o'clock at night. After a thorough search he selected the railway stable as a comfortable place for shelter. Noticing a small opening in the side of the structure, used chiefly to let in the air, he decided to enter by this way rather than climb over the door.

Having introduced his swag he was preparing to follow when the railway horse, who had never seen anything larger than a rat enter from that direction, seized the unfortunate man by the hand with such force that when he had rescued his bundle he had to seek the assistance of Dr. Gribble, who bound up the damaged hand, which showed some ugly teeth marks.

In the Garden 2021 No: 17 Companion planting; the big question is does it work?

There is limited scientific information on companion planting. Some combinations actually do work. It works well in the northern hemisphere but not as well down here in Australia. Information from books and the internet is 'scratchy' but gardeners know that it works.

Some plants do have the ability to repel insect infestations. Basil helps repel flies and mosquitoes; Caraway breaks down heavy soil. Asparagus, tomatoes, parsley, the aster family flower, dill, coriander, cucumber, strawberry, celery, radishes and corn are all happy together and support each other. Nasturtiums are a lovely plant and hardy, so snails and slugs do not really attack it. It is useful in salads and gives a tangy, light peppery flavour.

To me, companion planting is about trial and error, so if it works for you, tell your neighbour. I do think it does and we gardeners are always trialling something.

Asparagus	Basil, parsley, tomato
Beans	Beet, cabbage family, carrot, celery, corn, cucumber, pea, radish, strawberry, nasturtiums
Carrots	Bean, lettuce, onion, pepper, tomato
Melons	Corn, pumpkin, radish, squash
Potatoes	Beans, cabbage family, corn, eggplant
Cucumbers	Marigolds, nasturtiums, radish, beans
Dill	Cabbage
Geraniums	Roses
Hydrangeas	Daylillies
Iris	Phlox
Tulips	Hyacinths
Roses	Garlic

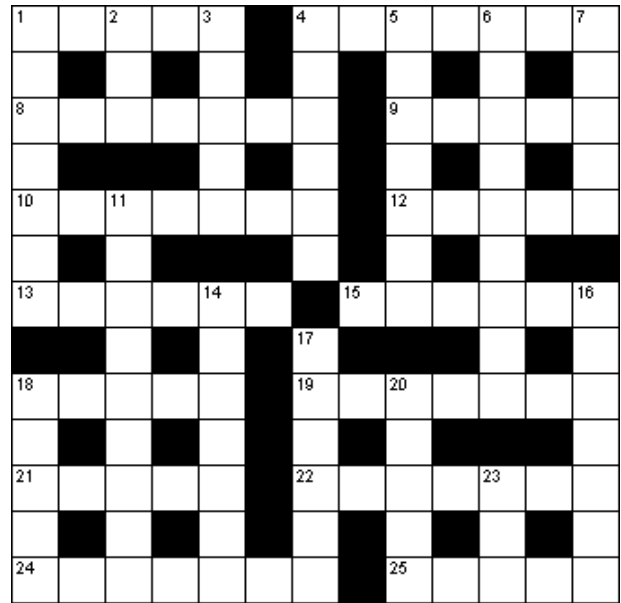
