

Have you ever considered growing Daisies or Geraniums? There are many new varieties and colours these days, and they are drought hardy as well as flowering for a long period of time. They also grow by slip or cuttings from the parent plant. Choose a cutting from last year's growth as the best.

There are different ways to strike cuttings. My method is, if you are able plant it when you get home, do so. If that is not possible, place it in water and keep it in that until you can.

In the Geranium and Daisy world there were the standard varieties. Now there are mixed varieties, which are most attractive and others. There are also Climbing Geraniums and Pelargonium, first cousins, that too make pretty displays and flower profusely. Keep them trimmed to whatever height you desire as they can get too tall and would need staking.

Yesterday's News

PORT WAKEFIELD

(The Chronicle, Oct 21st 1905)

October 13 — Yesterday when erecting a verandah at Mr. Witcomb's residence, the contractors found the iron too short.

Mr. Witcomb communicated by telephone from here with a firm at Port Adelaide, and the shipping company's boat landed the required iron with the necessary curving on the wharf here by 10 o'clock this morning, showing the benefit of the telephone and quick transit by the company's boats.

— About 6 a.m. today Mr. J. Lysaght, when coming into the port on a railway tricycle, felt the wheels give a jolt near the new iron bridge, and found he had run over a large brown snake, the wheels smashing the head. It is 5 ft. in length and 4 in, in girth. Snakes are numerous here this season.






