#### In the Garden 2021 No 19

Who are the most beneficial bugs in the garden? Lady Birds are probably the most recognized of all. Part of the reason is they eat quite a few bad guys. Lady Birds can eat up to 60 aphids a day, plus mealy bugs, leaf hoppers and mites.

Other good guys include Spined Soldier Beetles-- a type of stink bug --Braconid wasps and Tachnid Flies. These good guys love to snack on Aphids, White Flies, Mealy Bugs, Potato Beetle, Mites, Fleas and more. Green Lace Wings and Praying Mantis can handle the larger pests in your garden.

Our precious Bees are well known for their pollination of gardens and their ability to make honey. Birds also make a vital contribution, as they pick up almost every bug. Black Birds especially love to find and eat snails right out of the shell.

To keep the good guys in your garden safe, always be careful what insecticide you use. Happy Gardening!

#### Yesterday's News

The Wallaroo Times and Mining Journal November 29, 1876

PORT WAKEFIELD-The township is rather dull at present and there is no news unless to chronicle the doings of the larrikins, as Port Wakefield can boast of that class as well as other townships.

A new Post and Telegraph Office is being erected here under the Superintendence of a Clerk of Works who has won for himself the goodwill and wishes of all concerned, but by some means or other he has made himself obnoxious to that class just mentioned, and it culminated on Thursday night by his being set upon in the most brutal manner and pelted with rotten eggs. To an old Wallarooite it brought back recollections of days of yore.

As soon as he could escape he made his way to the Hostelry where he resides, and had to change the whole of his clothes for something not quite so offensive to the olfactory organs, Whether the Police will succeed in bringing offenders up to get their deserts remains to be seen, but all rightminded people hope they will be able to do so.




