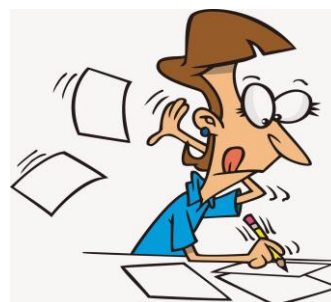

Port Wakefield Men's Shed

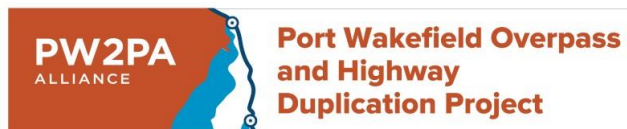
A reminder that the Men's Shed (open to all genders!) is open each Tuesday between approximately 10am to 1pm.

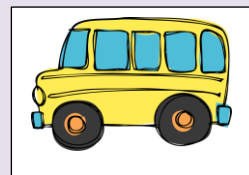

Yesterday's News

The Wooroora Producer August 30th, 1917

Australia Day at Port Wakefield.



PORT WAKEFIELD, Aug, 27 - - Australia Day was celebrated here on Saturday last, the weather being perfect, the attendance and result being in excess of previous years. A procession was formed near the ova! and marched through the principal streets. The pageant was one of the finest and most imposing ever seen in this locality. It was headed by mounted police, "Britannia" (Mrs P. J. McCarthy), escorted by lady riders, and followed by the town and district councils and Kadina Silver Band. The four queens with their escorts, vehicles of all descriptions, including the W.C.T.U car "Prohibition," in charge of Mr and Mrs W. A. Hewett and Mrs Donaldson. The Italian fishermen were conspicuous with their display, as well as a party of lady haymakers. The Wakefield "knutts" played a strong part rendering appropriate selections from their reed instruments.

The combined school children were ably marshalled by Mr Batterworth and the teachers. The Kadina Silver Band, accompanied by the Mayor of Kadina (Mr P. Roach), rendered fine service, stirring selections being given by the band. At the conclusion of the march appropriate addresses were delivered by the Mayor (Mr J. J. Thomas) and others, and patriotic selections were given by the massed schools.

A departure was taken this year by introducing four queens. The competition was very keen and resulted in the sum of £177 being realised. The results were—First, Queen of Agriculture (Miss Ivy Nicholls) ; second, Queen of Children (Miss Polly Fraser); third, Queen of Flowers (Miss P. Bampton); fourth, Queen of Sports (Miss D. Johnson). A special prize of £1 Is was presented by Mrs U. Donaldson for the best turn-out, and was secured by the Queen of Flowers trolley, decorated by Mrs C, H. Graham. A hand laundry also attracted much attention. The takings were far beyond other years, and when the full amount is to hand the sum of £500 will be attained. (. . .)

At the concert in the evening, given by the Waggs and the Dramatic Company, at which the successful Queen was crowned by the Mayor, a large number of persons had to be refused admission, the building being packed. The manager of the St. Alban and Foresters' halls gave the use of their buildings free of charge—which was considered most patriotic on account of the high price of carbide. 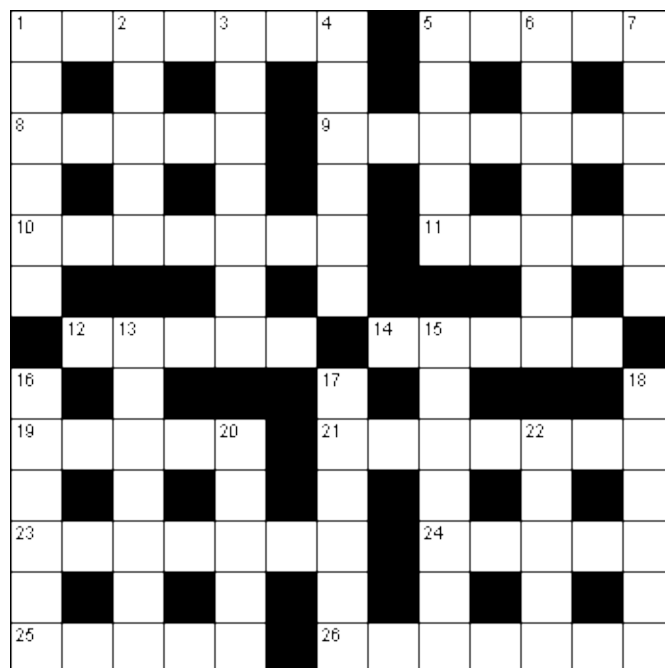
