#### LET'S GLOW!

#### Coconut Oil - The Miracle Oil - Final Part!

#### Deodorant

Coconut oil and baking soda is also an effective DIY deodorant. Be warned, it may take a few days for your body to adjust, but once it does, you may find that you no longer need super-strength commercial deodorants or antiperspirants.

#### Hand Sanitiser

Combine 6 drops of lavender or tea tree essential oil with 2 tablespoons of coconut oil, and rub it into your hands as a natural antiseptic moisturizer for your hands.

#### Improve Your Dental Health

Coconut oil can be a powerful weapon against bacteria, including Streptococcus mutans, the bacteria in your mouth that causes dental plaque, tooth decay, and gum disease.

In one study, swishing with coconut oil for 10 minutes - known as oil pulling - reduced these bacteria as effectively as rinsing with an antiseptic mouthwash. In another study, swishing daily with coconut oil significantly reduced inflammation and plaque in teenagers with gingivitis (inflamed gums)

#### STABBING AFFRAY AT PORT WAKEFIELD.

A big burly swagman, name unknown, got the worse for liquor on Saturday afternoon and became quarrelsome, and in the scuffle stabbed a man named Buckley in the neck.

M.C. Searson narrowly escaped being stabbed when arresting the man, and after a struggle pinned him to the ground and with assistance wrenched the knife from him. The arresting constable received a nasty kick in the face.

The prisoner when overcome became sulky and had to be carried to the lock-up, where he will be tried in the morning. Buckley's wounds were dressed by Dr. Gregerson, and he is progressing favorably, but had a narrow escape.


