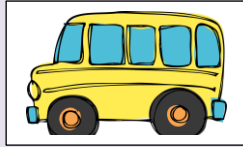

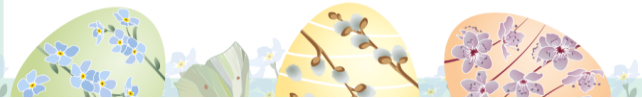

Homemade Face Scrubs – Part 2...

Homemade Face Scrub Recipes

Play around and find your personal best scrub recipe using some of the easy to make ideas below. In general, to make your own recipe you need a tablespoon or two of a scrubbing agent combined with a liquid or oil then add in any extras to give your scrub a boost. Give any one of these simple facial scrubs a try - most with two ingredients or less! - your skin will feel soft and smooth.

Dry Skin Face Scrubs:

Honey and Brown Sugar Scrub...

Honey and sugar are natural humectants (moisture preservers) that make a gentle scrub to buff away flakes, clear out pores, and lock in moisture. Sugar scrubs are common for body exfoliation and finer textured sugars can be used for making DIY face scrubs, just remember to be gentle.

- 1 tablespoon brown sugar (the finer, the better)
- 1 tablespoon honey, preferably raw

Mix the brown sugar and honey together. Then with clean fingertips, very gently apply the scrub to your face in small circular motions to aid in the exfoliation process without damaging the skin. Rinse with warm water and use a washcloth to remove any residual honey, if needed.

Coffee Face Scrub...

Leftover coffee grounds are mild enough to use for all over the body scrub—even on sensitive areas like the face. Plus, the used grounds are still chock full of caffeine and antioxidants [source] that reduce puffiness and leave the skin looking perky and toned.

- 1 tablespoon used coffee grounds
- 1 tablespoon oil (coconut oil, olive oil, or rosehip)

Berry and Olive Oil Scrub...

Strawberries and lemons are both sources of vitamin C, which helps fade skin discoloration and boost radiance. The brown sugar sloughs away dry skin flakes and olive oil replenishes moisture. Feel free to polish your lips as well!

- 4 ripe strawberries, mashed
- 3 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil
- 1/4 cup brown sugar
- Juice of 1/2 a lemon

Combine ingredients and apply to damp skin twice a week. Rinse and follow with moisturiser.

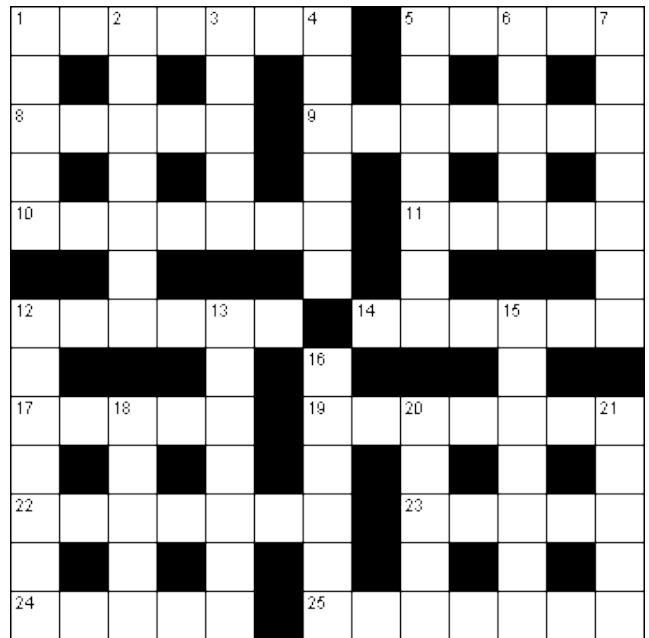
