Support Healthy Breathing...



Yesterday's News

Kapunda Herald June 23rd, 1905.



-- SWAGMEN --

Port Wakefield- During the past few weeks we have had a large consignment of swagmen. Some of them were probably looking for work; others did not want it at any price, while a few others were about beyond work and were in a wretched state, almost destitute of clothes and food, apparently fit for the hospital.

The visitors' behaviour was exceptionally good until last Thursday evening, when a sturdy 'sundowner' in a beery state called at the residence of Mr. J. Saunders, and demanded food in a very abusive manner. On being remonstrated with, he declined to leave the place, and M.C. Jones was sent for, who ordered him to leave the town, which he made a pretext of doing, but returned and was promptly arrested, and on being searched. had nearly £2 in his possession. He was brought next morning before the mayor, and contributed 5s. towards the revenue.

Friday night, several of the fraternity primed with "pinky" congregated near the railway crossing and became so boisterous that the police were sent for, and two of the leaders were arrested. They were arraigned next morning before Mr. J. Greenshields, who ordered them to be imprisoned for 24 hours, and then to quit the town, which advice they have acted upon, the place now being free from them.


