Weeds slow down in winter but if you pull them when they're young they're easy to keep down.


It's a good idea to add a layer of mulch now too. Feed winter vegetables with good fertiliser.


Some fast facts from Round 8:



#### Exciting Incidents at Port Wakefield

One or two days last week were of a very exciting nature. It appears that the other night, when most people were slumbering, two of our sports, armed and fitted up with the latest appliances for duck shooting, were out in the back regions driving a buggy and pair. When passing a water hole by some means they shot and wounded a solitary teal duck which they found swimming about half asleep. The crippled bird flew away into the night, hotly pursued by the hunters and volleys of shot. So eager were they to effect a capture that, not noticing the track they were on, all hands including the duck landed in a bunch in a small lagoon.

The horses, in their hurry to get through, left the buggy up to the body in slimy mud and sought refuge on dry land, followed by the hunters, who, after a chase, captured and rode the horses back to the township during the small hours of the morning. Next day we were advised by telephone that a lunatic, wearing bis birthday clothes, had been seen near a lagoon a few miles out. Arresting parties were sent out to secure the unfortunate man, and, on arriving at the locality, found a samaritan of a farmer had shed his clothes and was making heroic efforts to land the buggy which was sinking fast in the mud

This same night a small boy was reported missing, and search parties were out in all directions. Waterholes were dragged and so forth, and at about midnight he was found in the backyard of his parents' residence, having taken refuge there in the early part of the evening and forgot to announce that he wasn't lost.






