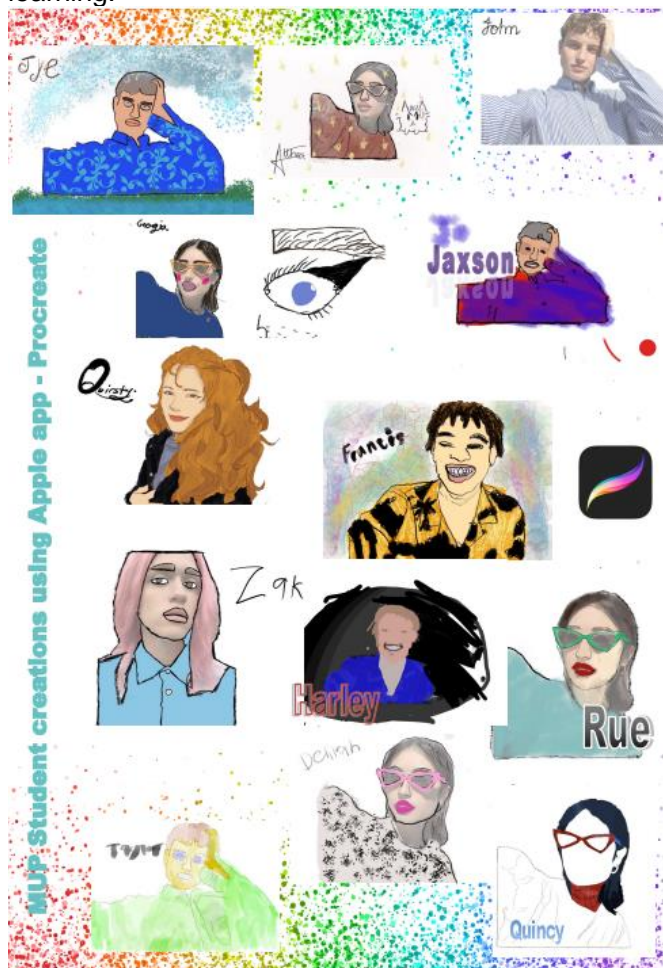
## Port Wakefield Primary School News

### Yesterday's News

*The Daily Herald* August 30<sup>th</sup>, 1917



#### AUSTRALIA DAY AT PORT WAKEFIELD.

August 28.—Perfect weather prevailed here on Saturday, when the Australia Day celebrations were held on the Oval grounds. A monster procession, headed by the Kadina Brass Band, paraded through the streets. After the opening address was delivered by the mayor, dinner was partaken of. Sports, horses over hurdles, tilting the ring, and sideshows and stalls of every description kept things moving along.

Money was good-naturedly given in all directions. A prize of £1 1/ (donated by Mrs. M. Donaldson) for best decorated vehicle in the procession was secured by the "Queen of Flowers." The queen competition was responsible for the netting of £177. the "Queen of Agriculture" (Miss Nicholls) being chosen as "Queen of Australia Day." Other queens were— Children, Miss P. Fraser; Flowers, Miss P. Bampton; Sports, Miss D. Johnson. In the evening a concert was given in the Foresters' Hall to a crowded audience, the sum of £25 being taken. The total takings will reach approximately £500.

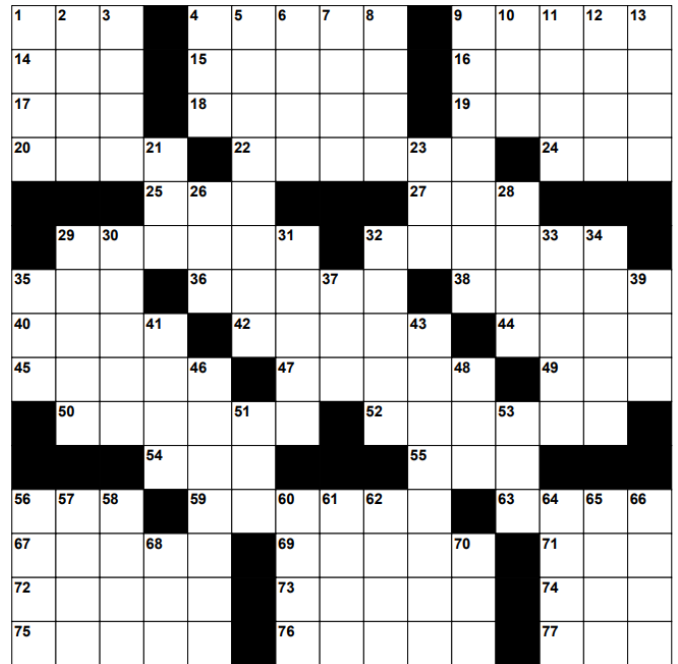
