#### DIY Sugar Wax For Face Waxing...

We've all heard the horror stories about waxing - the pain, the redness, the bleeding, the awkward grow-out phase. And that's just when waxing your legs. I'm convinced only the bravest among us are willing to try waxing their face. The first time I tried it, I left an obvious strip of peach fuzz down the middle of my upper lip. And the second time wasn't much better. But then I discovered sugar waxing, and let me tell you, it changed the game. Not only is sugar wax for the face less painful than traditional waxing, but it's also all-natural and practically foolproof (No ingrowns! No bleeding!).

So if you're willing to take the plunge, grab a cup of tea (or a glass of wine—you may need it for the rrrriiiip), and let's chat about the magic of sugar waxing.

#### What Is Sugar Wax?

If you've never made sugar wax before, this is a great starter recipe. Just note that there's no one-size-fits-all sugar wax recipe. Things like elevation, humidity, and room temperature will affect how the wax turns out, so don't give up if you fail the first few times.

#### **Sugar Wax Recipe**

- —1 cup white sugar —1/4 cup water —1/4 cup lemon juice
- 1. Combine the sugar, water, and lemon juice in a small, clean saucepan.
- 2. Without stirring your mixture, turn the burner to medium and wait until the sugar dissolves.
- 3. Once the sugar mixture starts bubbling, turn the heat down to medium-low and start stirring. Keep stirring until the wax becomes a deep golden brown and has the consistency of hot syrup.
- 4. To stop the cooking process, remove your sugar wax from the heat and transfer it to a heat-safe bowl. Let the wax cool for 30 minutes. It should be warm but still thick and pliable.

#### **How To Use Sugar Wax**

- 1. If needed, heat up the sugar wax so that it's warm and pliable but not too hot.
- 2. Test the wax to make sure it is not too hot. Then, using an applicator stick (or popsicle stick), apply a small amount of wax thinly and evenly against the direction of hair growth to make sure it fully coats the hair and really grabs it from the root (stay away from the eyes, lips and scalp)
- 3. Remove the wax place a muslin or cotton strip over the wax and press down firmly. Hold your skin taut with one hand and use the other hand to pull the wax off in the direction of the hair growth to avoid breaking the hair. It is not necessary to use fabric, your fingers will work fine too.
- 4. Repeat this process until done and then remove any excess wax

#### **Waxing Aftercare**

Facial skin can be finicky, so it's best to give it a little post-waxing TLC to keep redness at bay and promote quick healing.

- Apply a cold compress- Use a calming lotion
- Avoid hot water and sun exposure for at least 24 hours




#### **Hummocks Watchman Eagles Round 12 Round Up**



Port Wakefield, August 13- Shortly after noon yesterday a youth, in search of rabbits on a piece of ground known as the lagoon paddock, discovered a suspicious-looking animal crouching under some bushes, and having nothing but a small rifle to defend himself with, he decamped for home. After rousing his father from a troubled afternoon nap, he explained what he had seen.

Being an old sportsman, the man soon had a heavy musket in working order, and calling to his assistance another good shot, they, led by the boy, surrounded the bashes where a supposed fox, —or, maybe, bunyip—was concealed. Cutting off all retreat, they charged the bushes, with the boy well in the rear. Their efforts were rewarded by almost falling over a dead calf that had some days previously been thrown into these bushes.


