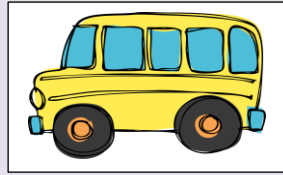

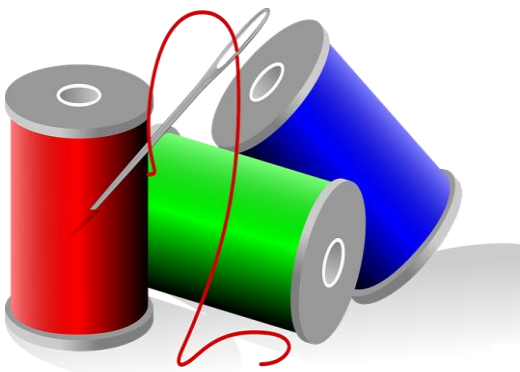

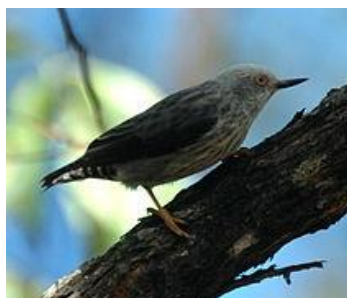

#### **Varied Sittella** *Daphoenositta chrysoptera*

The sittellas are social and generally restless birds of scrub, forests and woodlands. They live in clans of eight to twelve individuals and defend mutual territories against other groups.



Sittellas forage on horizontal branches and the trunks of trees. Their foraging techniques has been described as hopping rapidly along the length of a horizontal branch, pausing briefly to peer for prey, occasionally hanging underneath the branch but usually on top of it. Most of their time is spent on branches rather than on the trunks.


## Hummocks Watchman Eagles First Semi Final Round Up

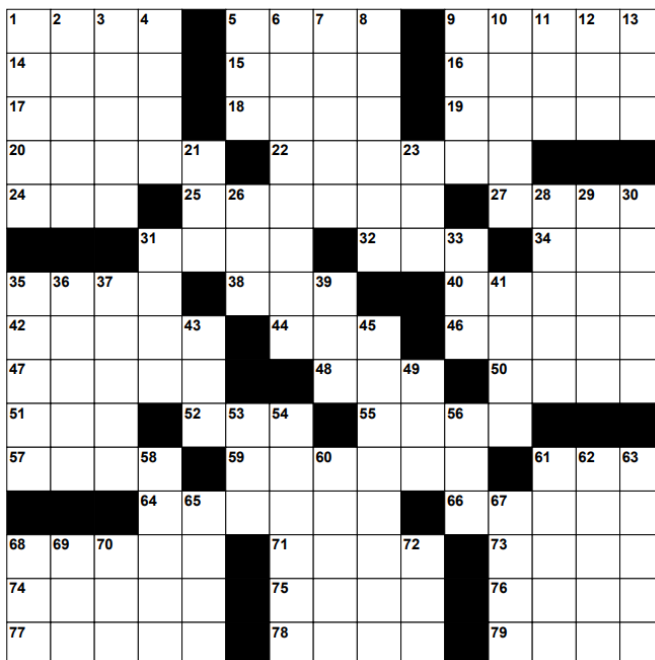

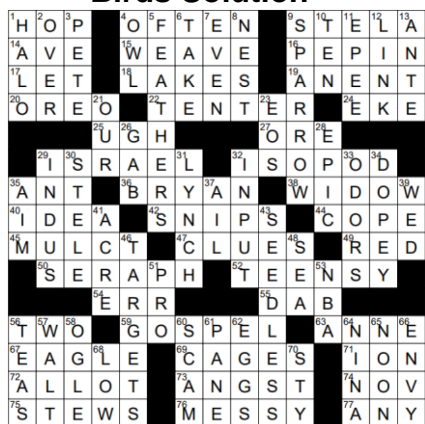
