**Yesterday's News**

*The Central Advocate* March 2, 1906



PORT WAKEFIELD. -- On Saturday a large party of excursioners left for Port Price, the advertised time to start being: 2.30 p.m., but through some misunderstanding with the tide the launch did not get underway until 4 p.m., when a fair gale was blowing outside. The brass band was on board, and the party had a fair passage through the channel to the strains of " A Little Ship was on the Sea." When once out on the gulf heavy seas were met, causing much consternation amongst the passengers. Men, woman, children, and baskets of provisions were mixed on indiscriminately ; people who had never spoken to each other for years ran towards one another, and after a hasty embrace sat down anywhere and anyhow; children and parents wept in unison, as at one moment the vessel seemed to be trying to harpoon something at the bottom of the sea, and the next trying to hit the clouds.

After passing over endless quantities of food to the ever-watchful fish Port Price was reached, when some of the party left to return by land, while some of the males had acquired such a thirst that some delay was caused while they replenished their inward feelings. The return journey was through boisterous seas, and the continued splashing of the ever-chasing waves made many soaking wet. Darkness and low tide prevented the vessel navigating the channel, and at a call from the launch eight boats pulled out and brought the passengers safely in, the last load reaching land about 9.30 p.m. Some excursion trips yesterday, but on account of finer weather were much enjoyed.

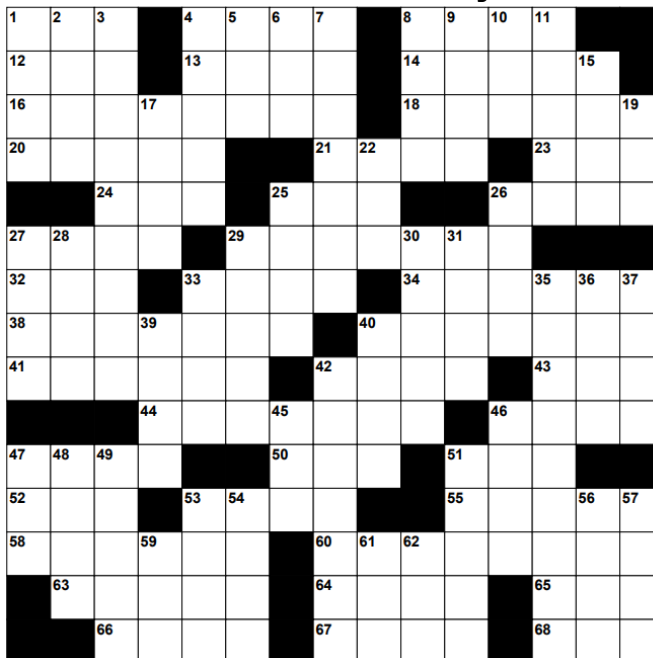
