If you have a team of 3 or just a single player looking to join the competition please message the Facebook group or contacts below and we will see if we can put a team together for you.

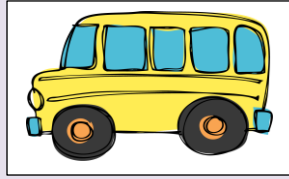

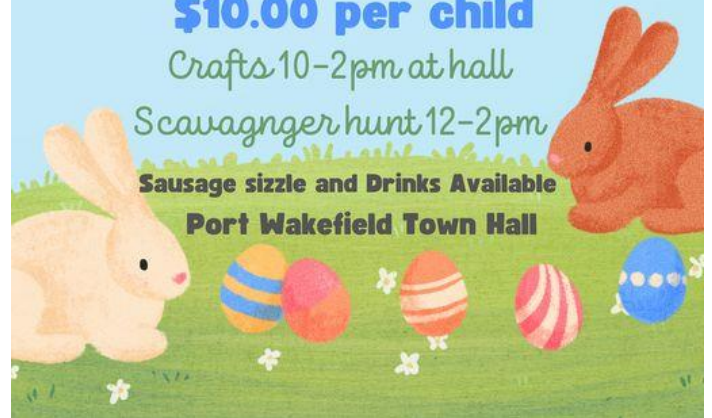

*The Central Advocate* March 23rd, 1906

Port Wakefield -- On Thursday and Friday last a man representing himself as being deaf and dumb, and bearing a letter to that effect, went round the town soliciting alms, and met with success on several occasions. At one place he was asked on paper to say what his name was, which he wrote on another slip in a handwriting that bore a strong resemblance to the letter he was showing around. He spent several quarters of hours here and there talking on his fingers to people. On Friday evening he visited the Rising Sun Hotel, and the landlord, becoming suspicious, ordered him out, and in the excitement of the moment the man displayed a strong amount of language, and showed himself an expert at hearing. He has since been missing.

## Easy Hot Cross Buns Recipe

### Ingredients:

- 500g (4 cups) **flour**
- 2 tsp **ground cinnamon**
- 1/2 tsp **ground nutmeg**
- 1/4 tsp **ground cloves**
- 1/4 tsp **ground allspice**
- 14g (2 packets) **dried yeast**
- 75g (1/3 cup) **caster sugar**
- 300ml (1 1/4 cups) **milk**, lukewarm
- 60g (1/4 cup) **unsalted butter**, melted
- 1 **egg**, lightly beaten
- 200g (1 1/3 cups) **mixed dried fruit** (raisins, currants, sultanas)
- **Flour paste for crosses** (made from flour and water)
- **Glaze** (made from apricot jam or sugar syrup)

### Instructions:

1. **Combine the dry ingredients:** In a large mixing bowl, mix the bread flour, ground cinnamon, ground nutmeg, ground cloves, ground allspice, dried yeast, and caster sugar.
2. **Add the wet ingredients:** Gradually add the lukewarm milk, melted butter, and beaten egg to the dry ingredients. Mix until a sticky dough forms.
3. **Knead the dough:** Turn the dough out onto a floured surface and knead it for about 10 minutes until smooth and elastic.
4. **First proving:** Place the dough in a greased bowl, cover it with plastic wrap, and let it rise in a warm place for about 1 hour or until doubled in size.
5. **Second proving:** After the first rise, gently knead the dough again and divide it into 16 equal portions. Shape each portion into a ball and arrange them in a square 23cm cake pan.
6. **Crosses:** Make the flour paste by mixing flour and water to form a smooth paste. Pipe crosses over the risen dough.
7. **Baking:** Preheat your oven to 180°C (350°F). Bake the buns for 10 minutes, then reduce the oven temperature to 160°C (320°F) and bake for another 20 minutes or until golden brown and the buns sound hollow when tapped on the base.
8. **Glazing:** While the buns are still hot, brush them with apricot jam or sugar syrup to give them a beautiful shine.

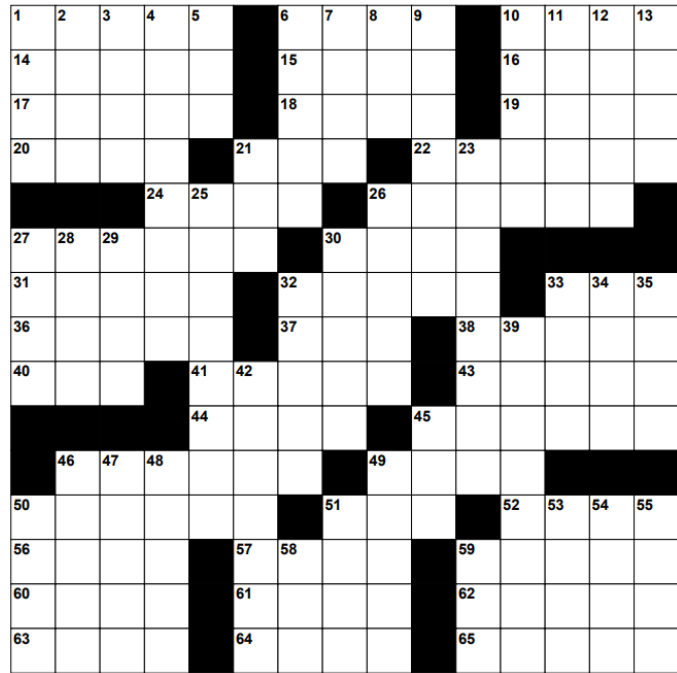
