- Company St/ Main St/ Edward St: 4/8/25

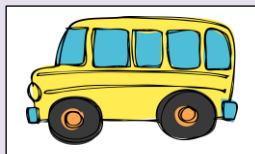

Yesterday's News

The Wooroora Producer August 22nd, 1918



During the past few weeks we have experienced several severe frosts, ending with most useful rains, which have brought the season's prospects to a very satisfactory position, and recent fears of a 1914 drought have about vanished.

The lambing season has been excellent, and the number of sheep is now greatly advanced. There are some good hauls of fish made now, and as with most things, fish from here can be bought much cheaper in Balaklava than at the port they come from.

Australia Day, which is to be held at the end of the present month, promises to eclipse its predecessors, as every effort is being put forward to make it a success. Owing to the great cause it is for, people are wondering why special trains cannot be obtained at a greatly reduced rate for such purposes.

A large number of fowls are mysteriously disappearing during the night time. The affair, however, now seems cleared up, through a well-known resident losing a pet gander the other night. In the small hours he heard a bird's terrified cries and what sounded like heavy footsteps, but not wishing so disturb the rest of the family he refrained from getting up until daylight was well advanced. On viewing the fowl house he found that his prize bird had gone, leaving behind a quantity of feathers. The law was quickly set in motion, and by noon the gander's skeleton, in company with other tame fowls' remains, were found in the Corporation quarry—the home of a gang of law-breaking foxes.

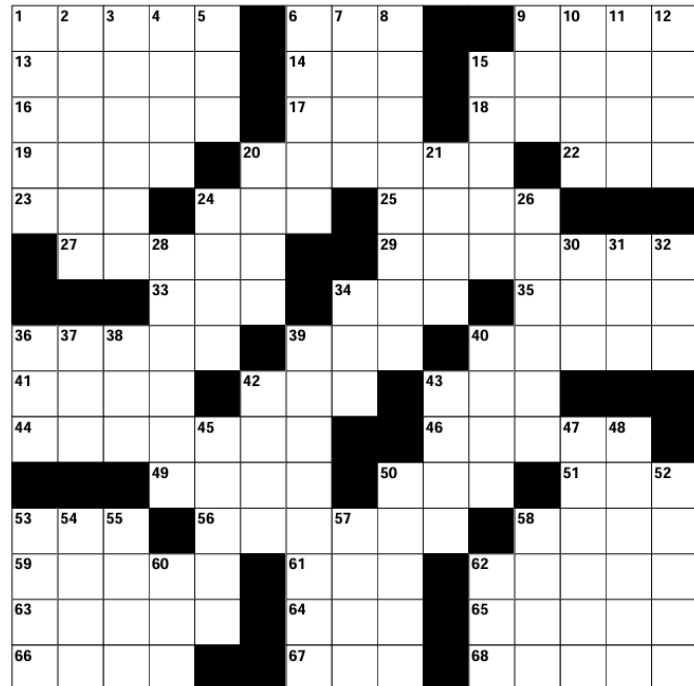
