



Kadina and Wallaroo Times September 7, 1904

The holiday passed off very successfully here yesterday, more attractions than usual being provided. At Wilddog Hill the annual picnic in connection with the Methodist Sunday School took place, there being a large attendance on the ground, every attention being paid by the officers to the wants of the young and the old, who put in a most enjoyable day's outing.

During the afternoon a football match was played on the school flat between a team from Kadina and the local team, resulting in a decisive victory for the visitors, which was not begrudged, as by their conduct throughout the match, and the general deportment while here, they have earned the name of being the gentlemanly team of young fellows who have ever visited this place,

Our local brass band gave an open-air concert in the oval at night, a large number being present to hear them in spite of the intense coldness. Several selections were rendered in a most creditable manner under bandmaster Mr T. Mitchell.

On Wednesday evening last a young lad named Strawhan accidentally shot himself through the foot. He was attended by Dr. Grabble, who ordered his removal to the Wallaroo Hospital.




